1. Venue

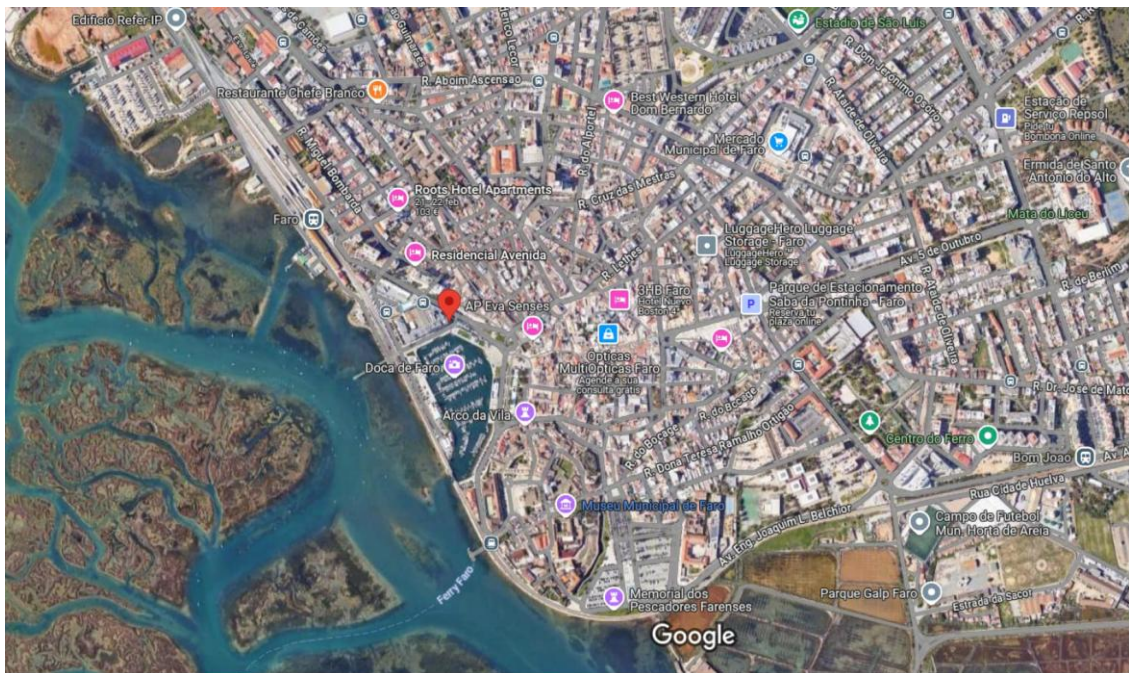
The ERIW25 will be held at a [Hotel AP Eva Senses](#) in Faro, in region of Algarve in Portugal.

Situated just 7 km from Faro Airport, the [Hotel AP Eva Senses](#) boasting a privileged view of the Marina and Ria Formosa Natural Park. AP Eva Senses is situated in city centre of Faro, conveniently located near to entertainment venues and the city's historic heritage.

Faro is the capital of the Algarve, in the south of Portugal. The Arco da Vila gives access to the old part of the city, known as Vila Adentro. From here, a maze of streets begins that is well worth walking through to discover its nooks and crannies. Outside the walls is a different city, rebuilt after the earthquake of 1755 by a wealthy nobility and bourgeoisie.

The city is also famous for its gastronomy, with fish and seafood cooked in the cataplana, a typical Algarve copper utensil that is thought to be of Arabic origin.

The Ria Formosa Natural Park is a lagoon system with a large area of marshes, channels and islets where several species of migratory birds can be observed. In the long stretch of sand that separates the estuary from the sea, there are quiet beaches such as the islands of Faro, Farol, Culatra and Deserta.
